

If you are currently using ACH, please change your offertory gift giving in one of the following ways:


- 1) Talk with your bank or utilize your bank online system to set up a recurring automated payment through the "Pay Bills" program.

Opening Prayer:



CELEBRATING THE SAINTS

ST WENCESLAUS (907 - 929), was born in Bohemia, in the Czech Republic. As Duke of Bohemia he supported the Church, ended persecution



of Christians, brought back exiled Priests and built churches. He also helped the poor, visited prisoners and worked to improve the religious and educational state of

his people. He also worked toward unification of Bohemia and made peace with Germany, which angered the anti-Christian forces. He was killed on his way to Mass by his pagan brother, Boleslaus and his supporters; before he died he asked God's mercy for his brother. He was immediately recognized as a martyr. Patron Saint of Bohemia,

All the technology and new classroom furniture has been purchased through grants that Susan has obtained for us over the years. The development of the courtyard with its wonderful playground, beautiful grassy area, and patio with tables and umbrellas has been completely paid for with grant funds. And now that has expanded to include a track and field in the upper area that otherwise was a vast, unused space.
